## ULTRAFLOW TRAFFIC PLAN INFORMATION

The City of Sevierville Ultraflow Traffic Plan is designed to provide the most efficient flow of traffic given the number of available roads and lanes in the downtown area. When implemented, it will provide relief to the overburdened Hwy. 66/Main Street intersection. The opening of Hwy. 448 (through Love Addition subdivision), coupled with additional traffic lanes and reconfigured use of the available traffic lanes on Parkway and Forks of the River Parkway will ease traffic congestion throughout the downtown area. Several other scheduled road projects will also provide traffic relief (visit [www.seviervilletn.org](http://www.seviervilletn.org) and click-on the Road Projects page for more info.).

## MAP INTERSECTION INFORMATION

(See map on reverse side.)

- ① Hwy. 66/Hwy. 448
  - Ⓐ Hwy. 66 north traffic may turn right onto Hwy. 448 or continue north
  - Ⓑ Hwy. 66 south traffic may turn left onto Hwy. 448 or continue south.
  - Ⓒ Hwy. 448 traffic north/west may turn right or left onto Hwy. 66.
- ② Hwy. 66/Chapman Hwy. (W. Main St.)/Main Street/Forks of the River Parkway
  - Ⓐ Forks of the River Parkway north traffic may turn left onto Chapman Hwy., turn right onto Main Street or continue straight onto Hwy. 66.
  - Ⓑ Hwy. 66 south traffic may turn right onto Chapman Hwy., turn left onto Main Street, or continue straight. (NOTE: An additional lane has been added so that three straight lanes are available through Forks of the River Parkway.)
  - Ⓒ Chapman Hwy. (W. Main Street) east traffic may turn right onto Forks of the River Parkway, turn left onto Hwy. 66 or continue straight. (NOTE: An additional lane has been added so that two lanes may go straight onto Main Street.)
  - Ⓓ Main Street west traffic may turn left onto Forks of the River Parkway, turn right onto Hwy. 66 or continue straight.  
**NOTE: it is recommended that traffic heading onto Hwy. 66 north (or to Interstate 40) use the new Hwy. 448 connector (see #4 on map).**
- ③ Forks of the River Parkway/Parkway
  - Ⓐ Parkway north traffic may turn left onto Forks of the River Parkway or continue straight. (NOTE: an additional north lane has been added so that three lanes may go straight.)
  - Ⓑ Parkway south traffic may turn right onto Forks of the River Parkway or continue straight.
  - Ⓒ Forks of the River Parkway south traffic may turn right onto Parkway.  
**NOTE: traffic heading onto Hwy. 66 north (or to Interstate 40) should continue straight on Parkway and use the new Hwy. 448 connector (see #4 on map).**
- ④ Main Street/Parkway/Hwy. 448
  - Ⓐ Parkway north traffic may turn left onto E. Main Street, turn right onto E. Main Street or continue straight onto Hwy. 448.
  - Ⓑ Hwy. 448 south traffic may turn right onto E. Main Street, turn left onto E. Main Street or continue straight onto Parkway.
  - Ⓒ E. Main Street east traffic may turn right onto Parkway, turn left onto Hwy. 448 or continue straight.
  - Ⓓ E. Main Street west traffic may turn left onto Parkway, turn right onto Hwy. 448 or continue straight.  
**NOTE: traffic heading onto Hwy. 66 north (or to Interstate 40) should use the new Hwy. 448 connector.**

## VISITOR RECOMMENDATIONS

Visitors traveling into or through Sevierville on Hwy. 66 should continue straight onto Forks of the River Parkway (Hwy. 441).

Visitors leaving Sevierville heading to Interstate 40 should use Parkway to Hwy. 448 to Hwy. 66.

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
