Mayor Atchley chaired the meeting with Lynn K. McClurg as secretary of the meeting. A motion was made by Alderman Helton and seconded by Vice-Mayor Fox to approve the minutes of the May 21, 2018 meeting and of the May 21, 2018 workshop and to dispense with the readings. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Mayor Atchley presented and placed for passage an ordinance O2018-008 entitled "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS, CAPITAL PROJECTS AND PUBLIC BUILDING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SEVIERVILLE FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD JULY 1, 2018-JUNE 30, 2019 AND ESTABLISHING A PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR THE TAX YEAR 2018. A motion was made by Vice-Mayor Fox and seconded by Alderman McGill to approve the ordinance as originally presented on first reading and to dispense with the reading. Fox clarified that his motion did not include additional in lieu of tax or interest revenues discussed at the prior meeting. Those voting Yes:

Fox, Helton, McGill. Those voting No: McCroskey. Atchley declared the ordinance passed on second reading.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Atchley presented a resolution R2018-005 Formally Adopting Americans With Disability Act (ADA) Standards for Accessibility in the City of Sevierville. A motion was made by Alderman McGill and seconded by Alderman Helton to approve the resolution as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Bryon Fortner, who presented a scope of services and contract in a lump sum not to exceed amount of \$34,900.00 with Robert G. Campbell and Associates for engineering design services for the West prong Greenway Extension. Fortner noted that TDEC grant funds will reimburse \$21,250.00 of the expense and that the firm was selected through a qualifications-based selection (QBS) process. A motion was made by Alderman McCroskey and seconded by Vice-Mayor Fox to approve the scope of services and contract as requested. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Lynn McClurg, who requested approval and/or ratification of the following expenditure(s) in excess of \$5,000.00:

1. NAPA	Fleet A/C service machine	\$5,635.00	Low price
2. Land Air	Police radios	\$6,225.45	State contract
3. Kodak Tractor	Commercial mower	\$6,400.00	Low price

A motion was made by Alderman Helton and seconded by Vice-Mayor Fox to approve the expenditure(s) as presented. Motion carried.
