A motion was made by Vice-Mayor Fox and seconded by Alderman McGill to approve the ordinance as presented and to dispense with the reading. Those voting Yes: Fox, Helton, Koester, McCroskey, McGill. Those voting No: None. Atchley declared the ordinance passed on second reading.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Atchley recognized Brenda McCroskey, Sevierville Chamber of Commerce, who presented bids for the 2019 Vacation Planner & Coupon Book and recommended acceptance of the low bid and award the contract to CJK Printing in the amount of \$212,300.00. A motion was made by Alderman McGill and seconded by Alderman McCroskey to approve the bid and award the contract as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Bryon Fortner, who presented bids for an annual contract for high friction surface treatment services and recommended acceptance of the low qualified bid and award of contract to Truesdell corporation. A motion was made by Alderman Koester and seconded by Vice-Mayor Fox to approve the bid and award the contract as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Bryon Fortner, who presented a scope of services and fee proposal with Cannon & Cannon, Inc. for on-call traffic engineering services with expenditures limited to budgeted amounts. A motion was made by Vice-Mayor Fox and seconded by Alderman Helton to approve the scope of services and fee proposal as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Matt Henderson, who requested approval to purchase duty uniforms from various low quote vendors in amounts not to exceed the budget of \$56,000.00. A motion was made by Alderman McCroskey and seconded by Vice-Mayor Fox to approve the purchases as requested. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Steve Flynn, who requested approval to purchase a track hoe under state contract (SWC219/50614) from Stowers in the amount of \$64,993.00. A motion was made by Alderman Helton and seconded by Vice-Mayor Fox to approve the purchase as requested. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Steve Flynn, who presented bids for a service truck engine and recommended the purchase from McNelly Whaley in the amount of \$13,275.00. A motion was made by Alderman McCroskey and seconded by Alderman McGill to approve the bid and award the contract as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Steve Flynn, who requested approval of an amended memorandum of agreement among the Tennessee Valley Authority, the Tennessee State Historic Preservation Officer, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, the Muscogee Nation and the City for archaeological work at the waste water treatment plant expansion site. Flynn noted that the revision was requested based on language the Tribes wanted to add and that it had been reviewed by the City Attorney. A motion was made by Alderman McGill and seconded by Alderman Koester to approve the memorandum as presented. Motion carried

Mayor Atchley recognized Steve Flynn, who presented bids for three installed pneumatically actuated ball pump check valves and recommended the purchase from John Bouchard & Sons in the

amount of \$127,402.99. A motion was made by Alderman Helton and seconded by Vice-Mayor Fox to approve the bid and purchase as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Atchley recognized Tracy Baker, who presented an amendment to the food and beverage agreement with Spectra Food Services, LP. Baker explained that the amendment corrects an error and reverts the terms related to capital purchases to \$500,000.00. A motion was made by Alderman McGill and seconded by Vice-Mayor Fox to approve the contract amendment as presented. Motion carried
