

Active Afternoons

2016 - 2017

Welcome to the Kids Unlimited Programs! Kids Unlimited consists of four programs throughout the year for children. Active Afternoons takes place each afternoon following the school day. Summer Adventure is a seven week program held during the summer. Flurry of Fun takes place during the Christmas break and Spring Extreme is held during the week of spring break. All of these programs are supervised, organized, structured and extremely recreational. Our staff has been carefully selected to provide your child with a safe, active, fun alternative to regular childcare. We provide excellent supervision of children, but our main purpose is to provide unlimited activities which include all kinds of sports, field trips, art, plus many more games and activities. Our goal is to provide children with a wide variety of activities. There is something for everyone.

Active Afternoons

Registration Information: Families involved in the Active Afternoons Program during the 2015/2016 school year, may register for Active Afternoons 2016/2017 when registration forms become available. You will need to register, by May 19, 2016, as we will begin filling openings on May 23. To register, see Deanna Hutchens, Recreation Supervisor. For questions about Active Afternoons contact Deanna at 868-1875. A completed registration form and the first month's fee (September 2016) are required at registration. This fee/deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable to other children or programs.

Program Dates and Times: Dates: Follows school schedule; program will start on the first full day of school and end on the last full day of school. If school is released early due to any reason, there will be no program.

Times: The program and supervision by the program staff begins at the time of pick up (approximately 3:00 pm) – ends at 5:30 pm.

Only full-time registration is accepted, even if your child does not attend the program everyday.

Fees: Monthly payment: \$75 per child. December and April payment is \$57 per child because of the school system breaks. The monthly payment is due at the first of each month and should be given to Deanna. Fees are subject to change.

Ages: Kindergarten – 6th grade. On occasion, an older child may be allowed to participate in this program. Anyone beyond the age limit may not be allowed to participate in tournaments and competitions.

Basic Activities: An activity schedule will be available each month. Various activities include soccer, swimming, bowling, archery, fitness programs, volleyball, art projects, basketball, dodgeball, kickball, football, whiffleball, tennis, polo, picnionary, karaoke, bingo, cooking class, holiday events and activities, tournaments, competitions, plus many more games, sports, special events and activities. Children also have the option of participating in a monthly field trip. Some potential field trips for this school year are: the Sevier County Fair, Kyker Farm Corn Maze, Dollywood Christmas Festival, Wilderness Indoor Water Park, Ober Gatlinburg Snow Tubing and White Water Rafting. Participating in field trips is optional, generally cost extra and must be sign up for. The program will be as normal at the community center for children that do not wish to participate in the field trips.

A snack is provided daily.

What To Bring: Children should wear appropriate clothing and shoes for the scheduled activities and for the weather conditions. We go on with our schedule, even in rain and/or cool temperatures - if at all possible. Parents may wish to provide sunscreen - as we are outside many afternoons. Socks are needed for bowling; swimsuit and towel are needed for swim days. We encourage children to bring a drink bottle with a lid that does not leak. Consult the activity schedule to determine if additional items are needed. Children are responsible for keeping up with all their belongings.

If your child chooses to bring valuable electronics, such as phones, iPods and gaming systems, it should be understood that most of the time the children's items are not in a secure place and these items are at risk of being stolen or damaged. Also, if your child brings an item such as this, the content and material, including music, games, pictures and internet usage should be appropriate for all ages involved in our program.

Medication: If your child needs to receive medication while they are attending the program, you must fill out a medication release form. Please see a staff person for one of these forms.

Pick Up Procedure:

Intermediate School Children – A Kids Unlimited staff member will meet the Intermediate School children in the Intermediate School gym immediately following school.

Middle School Children – Middle School children should meet the Kids Unlimited staff on the football field behind the Intermediate School. See note below concerning bad weather days.

Primary School Children – Children in the program will ride a school bus to the Intermediate School. The kids in our program will be on one bus, with no children above the second grade on board. The bus will be going directly from the Primary to the Intermediate; they will not be on a bus route. A Kids Unlimited staff member will meet the bus at the time it arrives at the Intermediate School. Kids in our program will depart the bus before any Intermediate or Middle schoolers get on.

Children participating in this program should be in the correct place listed above immediately when school dismisses. It will be assumed that if a child is not at the appropriate place in a timely manner, they are not participating in the program for that day. These pick up procedures could change based on decisions made by the school system. Please check with the Program Supervisor to confirm these procedures.

In the event of rain and on very cold days, we may pick the children up in our City bus. When these conditions exist, the Middle School kids should look for the Kids Unlimited staff at the Trula Lawson covered porch area instead of the football field.

On rare occasions, it is possible that our bus would not be available for our program to use. Therefore, we may have to walk in the rain or very cold temperatures, occasionally. Please prepare your child for these conditions by providing them with the appropriate clothing and/or an umbrella.

Release Form: I, the below signed, state that I will not hold the City of Sevierville, Sevierville Parks and Recreation Department, or any persons connected with this program responsible or liable for any accident which may occur while my child is participating in the program. I have read the attached material and I am aware of the activity schedule. I give my permission for my child to be involved in all activities during the program. I also authorize the Parks and Recreation Department staff to obtain emergency treatment for my child in the event that I cannot be reached.

I release the Sevierville Parks and Recreation from any claim for damages or compensation for their use of photographs and/or video of my child taken, individually or in a group, while my child is participating in activities sponsored by the department. All photographs and/or video shall become the absolute property of the Sevierville Parks and Recreation, which shall be entitled the use of all photographs and video. Photos and/or names might be used in the media, including the internet.
