## The Leaves Are Falling!

While many residents spend a day or two raking or blowing leaves at home each fall, Mark Matthews and his co-workers spend many weeks collecting leaves throughout the City. Mark, who has been with the [Public Works Department](#) for 13 years, and a co-worker operate one of several [leaf collection](#) trucks that are in service from October into January. When their truck is full (which is one-two times/day), the leaves are taken to Sevier Solid Waste and used as a compost component.

Mark takes pride in his role in the collection process and offers residents a couple of tips to ensure all of

- Build leaf piles along the curb on your property and no further than three feet from the road, the maximum reach of the suction tube.
- Place leaves and brush in separate piles. The collection trucks for each are different, so mixing will result in some leaves and brush being left behind.

## Residential Garbage Collection Guidelines

The City of Sevierville [Solid Waste Department](#) strives to always meet the needs of our residential garbage customers. There are many factors that can affect residential collection, such as equipment breakdowns, utility/road work in a neighborhood, and holidays. When these challenges occur, we may need to collect garbage earlier or later than usual so we recommend that customers place their garbage containers at curbside no later than 6AM on your scheduled collection day, or even the night before collection.
