Code Red Tests Planned on Friday

As part of Tennessee Severe Weather Awareness Week, the City of Sevierville, along with Sevier County and other area cities, will be testing the Code Red alert notification system. Code Red is designed to keep the community informed in the event of an emergency or other important event.



The test will take place at approximately 10:00AM tomorrow, Friday, March 2, 2018. At this time, all City of Sevierville residents who have registered to receive the free Code Red alerts should receive a test alert message.

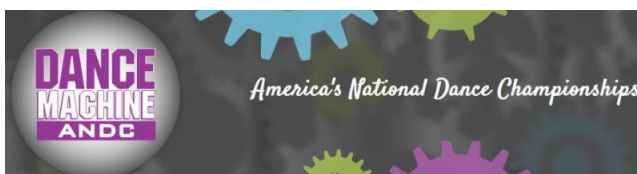
Please take a moment to fill in the appropriate information below to be notified by your local event of emergency situations or critical community alerts. Examples include: evacuation notices, and missing child reports.
