New Main Fire Headquarters Construction Update



Despite above average rainfall this winter, construction of Sevierville's new Main Fire Station (1162 Dolly Parton Parkway) continues to move forward. Although contractors were forced to excavate saturated soils and backfill with gravel in the area of the building foundation, footings are now 100% complete and the building foundation (slab) should be finished the first week of April, weather permitting.
