Commercial Building Fire Inspections Ongoing



Perhaps the most important task that the [Sevierville Fire Department](#) performs throughout the year is fire prevention. One aspect of fire prevention is inspection of commercial and public buildings.

The SFD is currently focusing fire prevention efforts on commercial buildings to ensure that all businesses are operating within the fire code for the safety of the public and their respective employees.

Inspectors will be looking for compliance with Life Safety Code violations and target fire hazards such as blocked fire exits, improperly working or uninspected fire extinguishers, emergency lights, exit signs and fire sprinkler systems. They will also watch for certain items that are common causes of fires both locally and nationally, including extension cords, improperly stored items or cluttered storage areas. Recent pictures of fires in our city caused by these items are available on the City website Fire Department pages (www.seviervilletn.org).

Inspectors will be enforcing code requirements when violations are present.

Officer Certified as Drug Recognition Expert

[Sevierville Police Department](#) Officer Justin Armstrong recently graduated from [Drug Recognition Expert](#) school. A drug recognition expert (DRE) is a police officer trained to recognize impairment in drivers under the influence of drugs other than, or in addition to, alcohol.

Officers trained as DREs are frequently called upon to differentiate between drug influence and medical and/or mental disorders. Their highly-specialized training provides an extremely valuable tool for combating the adverse impact of drug and alcohol impaired driving in our communities.



"The DRE training is very demanding and graduating is quite an accomplishment," said SPD Captain Matt

Ayers. "Officer Armstrong is a tremendous asset to our department and community in our efforts to combat impaired driving." Officer Armstrong is the agency's first DRE, and one of only a few in our county.

Traffic Advisory: North Parkway Bridge



TDOT contractors have scheduled gas pipeline inspections and repairs on the North Parkway bridge near downtown Sevierville next week.

The right southbound travel lane on the North Parkway (Ultraflow) bridge, between Burrigge Drive and Main Street, will be closed from approximately 8:30AM-6PM on May 7, 8 and 9.

Motorists should expect delays and consider an alternate route. Work is conditional based upon weather.

Traffic System Improvement Work Continues



The [City of Sevierville](#) and contractors are continuing their traffic signal retiming work as the City moves towards implementation of a traffic responsive system, wherein traffic signals communicate in real-time to respond to traffic levels, resulting in increased traffic flow efficiency. Motorists should be alert for changes in timing and signal phases.

The project is 100% federally-funded and includes the entire Highway 66 corridor, Dolly Parton Parkway, Main Street, the Parkway into Pigeon Forge, and Veterans Boulevard into Pigeon Forge.
