Monday, June 18 - Friday, June 22. Camp will take place daily from 8:00AM - 4:00PM.

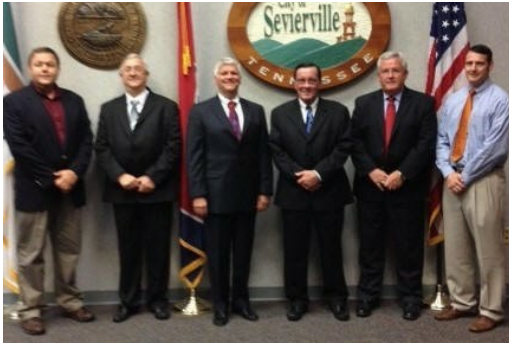
