## Fire Department Offers CPR and Stop the Bleeding Class

The Sevierville Fire Department is offering a CPR and Stop the Bleeding class from 8AM-2PM on Saturday, June 9 at Fire Station 1

## SAVE A LIFE: What Everyone Should Know to Stop Bleeding After an Injury

(main downtown station), 122  
Prince Street.

The 6-hour class is open to the public and will begin at 8AM and end at 2PM. The class fee is \$22.00/person (checks payable to the City of Sevierville), which includes all class materials and a

certificate. Classes have been filling-up quickly, so to ensure a spot please pay in advance by bringing a check to Fire Station 1 or by mail to 122 Prince Street, Sevierville, TN 37862.

In this classroom-based course, participants will learn to recognize several life-threatening emergencies, provide CPR to victims of all ages, and learn how they can control severe bleeding to save themselves and others.

The SFD offers this class to educate providers, caregivers, and the general public on how to respond to certain emergencies, and to increase public awareness of the importance of early intervention to save lives.

## Outdoor Pool Is Open For Summer fun!



Why not spend your Sundays at the City Park Family Aquatic Center this summer? The Family Aquatic Center (outdoor pool, slide and splash play area) at City Park is open for summer fun!

This will be the 44th summer that the FAC has been open. A lot of changes have been made over the years, including pool refinishing, new filtration system, rebuilt office and concessions area, expanded pool deck with shade structures, and most notably the addition of a slide and splash play area.

The operating hours for the season are 11AM-5PM Monday-Saturday and 1PM-5PM Sunday. (The Family Aquatic Center will close at 4PM due to swim meets

on June 12, 14, 19 and 23.)
