## Proposed FY 2019 City Budget Passes on Third and Final Reading



The proposed City FY 2019 budget was passed on the third and final reading at the Board of Mayor and Aldermen meeting on June 18. The City 2019 fiscal year is July 1, 2018-June 30, 2019.

The budget included an increase in the Lodging Tax from 2% to 3%. No other taxes were increased or implemented, including the property tax which remained unchanged. There are increases in some Parks and Recreation fees, garbage collection fees and new fees for some

Fire Department commercial inspection services. The complete budget will be available on the [City website](#) within the next several days.
