The [Sevierville Police Department](#) has scheduled a 9-hour Rape Aggression Defense (R.A.D.) class for women on July 19, 26 and August 2 from 6PM-9PM. Participants must attend all classes; no make-up classes will be available. The July 19 and 26 classes will be held at

the Civic Center; the August 2 class will be held at the Police Department. The class is free of charge and is open to all interested women. The purpose of the class is to develop and enhance self-defense options, so they may become viable considerations to a woman if she is attacked.
