Recycling Bin Education

City's Recycling Program May Be In Jeopardy

The City of Sevierville has two drop-off locations for single stream recycling containers. Each container is clearly marked with items the recycling company will take. Unfortunately, many people who use the containers do not follow the guidelines. Some residents have recently started using the containers for their household garbage. If this continues the recycling company may refuse to take the material, which would eliminate the City's ability to provide recycling for the community.

Everyone can help by removing items from plastic bags and placing only the following materials in recycling bins:

Cardboard	Newspaper, Magazines, Junk Mail, Office Paper, etc.
Aluminum/Tin/Steel Cans	Plastic Bottles & Containers

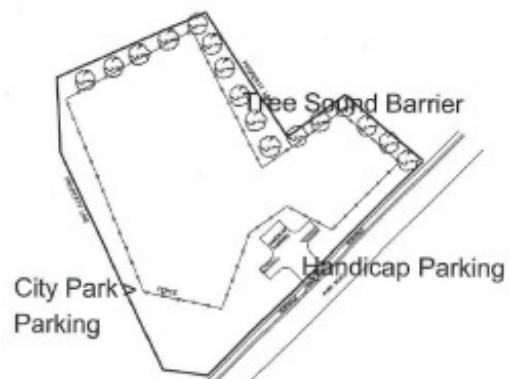
The following items are not accepted by the recycler and when mixed with recyclable materials can require the entire container to be taken to the landfill:

Household Garbage	Used Diapers	Food Waste (includes fresh vegetables)
Glass	Plastic Bags	Styrofoam/Styrofoam Containers
Wood	Metal	Clothing/Bedding
Shrink Wrap	Plastic Sheeting	Electronics (TV's & computers)

Recycling locations are not to be used for dropping off junk, TV's, or yard waste. If you leave within the city limits of Sevierville curbside junk and yard waste pickup is included in your garbage fee.
