### New 4-Way Stop at Middle Creek Road and Blanton Drive/Millwood Drive Intersection

The City is planning to install a new 4-way stop at the intersection of Middle Creek Road and Blanton Drive/Millwood Drive. Despite the current 2-way stop and the installation of warnings, this intersection has been the site of an above average number of vehicle crashes. An engineering study determined that a traffic signal was not warranted, even with the number of traffic crashes. However, a 4-way stop is warranted. This new traffic pattern should greatly reduce the number of traffic crashes without significantly affecting traffic efficiency.

City Public Works crews were out in earnest several times last month to combat snow and ice. Thanks to their efforts the majority of City roads remained passable.
