New Traffic Signal on Collier Drive Approved

On March 7, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen approved a plan to install a new traffic signal on Collier Drive near the Parkway. A recently completed traffic study recommended the new signal to reduce the number and severity of traffic crashes near the entrance to Quaker Steak and Lube. City staff will work with contractors on design and implementation.

Please...Keep Your Butts Where They Belong!

Keep Sevier Beautiful and the Sevierville Police (SPD) and Fire (SFD) Departments are joining to bring awareness to both the dangers and unsightliness of discarded cigarette butts. The SFD says there have been 177 documented fires in Sevierville due to discarded cigarette butts in the past ten years. SPD

Parks and Recreation Completes Energy Audit

The Sevierville Parks and Recreation Department recently partnered with the Sevier County Electric System and Tennessee Valley Authority to conduct energy audits of the Community Center, Municipal Complex parking areas and trail lighting system that was installed in the late 1980's. As a result of the audits, staff is recommending replacement of Community Center exit signs, gymnasium and natatorium lights, and Municipal Complex parking lot and trail lights with energy efficient LED lights and fixtures.
