Police and Fire Departments Receive Wal Mart Grants

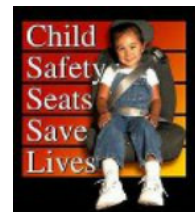

PublicStuff App Discontinued

The PublicStuff service request app for smart phones and tablets available to residents since 2014 is being discontinued. The relatively low number of users and service requests submitted via the app have not reached desired levels. Downtown Square Renovations Near Completion

Over the past several months, City staff have been working to renovate and improve the old Town Square located at Main Street and Court Avenue. The Parks and Recreation and Public Works Departments have utilized City staff to greatly enhance the appearance and usefulness of the square. The improvements include repairs and cleaning of the fountain; repairs of commemorative plaques; sidewalk repair; installation of new wayfinding signs; new landscaping; light pole and parking lot repairs; and crosswalk repairs. The work is expected to be completed in the next few weeks.

First Phase of Veterans Boulevard Extension Planned

A construction contract on Phase 1A of the extension of Veterans Boulevard has been awarded to Charles Blalock and Sons, Inc. The \$1.175 million project is scheduled to begin in April and take an estimated six months to complete. Veterans Boulevard will be extended several hundred feet north from the current intersection with Dolly Parton Parkway and create space for new development on the northeast corner. Phase 1B (not yet scheduled) will extend Veterans Boulevard across the West Prong of the Little Pigeon River to Robert Henderson Road.
