The Sevierville Fire Department (SFD) is planning to remove the current temporary ban on open burning in the City. The ban has been in effect for most of April due to extremely dry conditions and multiple brush and structure fires in the area.

The ban will be lifted beginning May 2, 2016.

The City of Sevierville has launched a new permitting process and website. Contractors and residents will now have the ability to:

- Apply and pay online for permits
- Submit plans, surveys and documents "paperless" in PDF Format
- Track application progress up to permit issuance
- View and print copies of letter documents received from Sevierville any time
- Request inspections online
- View and print completed inspection reports
- Receive real-time e-mail notifications when an inspection is completed.
