Highway 66 Improvements Evident During Memorial Day Weekend

The results of numerous improvements along the Highway 66 corridor over the past year were evident over the Memorial Day Weekend, as traffic in the City flowed extremely well for one of the busiest holiday periods of the year. Just before the weekend, contractors were able to open all three northbound lanes in the construction zone and three southbound lanes near the intersection with Boyds Creek Highway. All southbound lanes through the construction zone are estimated to be open in approximately two months. Other improvements over the past year include:

Opening of the Diverging Diamond at I-40 Exit 407 Addition of right and left turns on red at Exit 407 off ramps Flashing Yellow Left Turn arrows at many intersections Installation of traffic cameras throughout Highway 66 and the Parkway

SPD Collects Over 200 Pounds of Drugs During Drug Take Back Event

As a full-time partner with the Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA), the City of Sevierville Police Department (SPD) participated in a National DEA Drug Take Back Event on Saturday, April 23, 2016 at the City Municipal Complex. Staff and volunteers collected 245.20 pounds of unwanted drugs from residents, which was over twice the amount received in any previous event.

Citizens may drop-off drugs at the SPD Drug Take Back receptacle any time or day of the week. The service is free and anonymous. The following drugs are accepted: all loose pills and powders; liquid drugs in sealed packaging; sealed drugs and aids (i.e. diabetic supplies, meters, etc.). The department is unable at this time to accept syringes or other types of drug paraphernalia. Anyone with questions may contact Lt.
