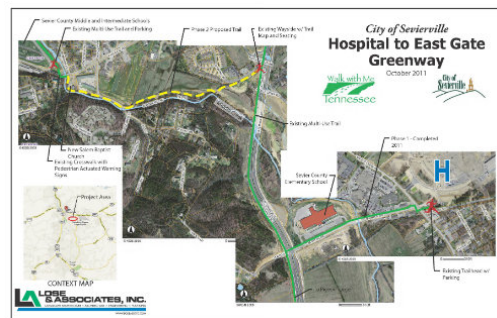

Phase II Greenway Work Underway!

The City of Sevierville Department of Parks and Recreation announces that work is underway on the Phase II Greenway Project, which connects two existing greenways.

The Phase II project will connect the greenway on Eastgate Road that currently ends at the New Salem Baptist Church with the greenway on Middle Creek Road at Sunrise Circle and Veterans Boulevard. The greenway will be a 10' wide multi-use trail for pedestrians and bicyclists.

Got Drugs? Drug Take-Back Event Scheduled

As a full-time partner with the Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA), the City of Sevierville Police Department (SPD) will participate in a National DEA Drug Take Back Event on Saturday, October 22, 2016 from 10:00AM-2:00PM at the Sevierville Police Department, 300 Gary Wade Blvd.

In addition to dropping-off drugs at this event, citizens may drop-off drugs at the SPD Drug Take Back receptacle any time or day of the week. The service is free and anonymous. The following drugs are accepted: all loose pills and powders; liquid drugs are only accepted in sealed packaging; sealed drugs and aids (i.e. diabetic supplies, meters, etc.).

City Proposes Changes to City Charter

City of Sevierville residents who have registered to vote will have an opportunity to vote on two proposed changes to the City charter on national election day, November 8, 2016.

Under the current charter, City Aldermen are elected based upon who receives the most votes in a given election. If there are two Aldermen seats open, the top two vote recipients overall are elected. The proposed charter change would require candidates to choose a

specific seat to run for and the top vote recipient for that particular seat would be elected.

The second proposed charter change would allow the Board of Mayor and Aldermen to set the dates and times of regular board meetings by ordinance, instead of the current requirement of changing the City charter to set new regular meeting dates and times. This will allow the Board more flexibility to set regular meeting dates and times that would benefit the schedules of residents and Board members.

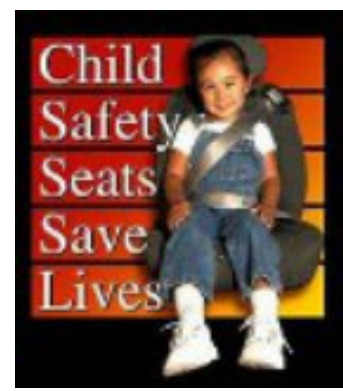
