



City of Sevierville Tennis/Pickleball Court Facility Use and Lighting Policy Revised April 28, 2022

Purpose: Due to the number of different groups types that request to use the Tennis/Pickleball Courts at City Park; it is imperative that a structure of scheduling priorities be established in order to maximize the usage and be consistent with all users.

The list below will be the priority order that the City of Sevierville Parks and Recreation staff will utilize when scheduling the Tennis/Pickleball Courts at the City Park.

Spring Season (Mid-Feb until Mid-May)

Summer/Fall Season (Mid-May thru October)
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sevier County Junior Tennis (Thru October) 2. Public Usage 3. Private Lessons or Rental <p>*#1 users occur in late afternoon and evenings</p> <p>Other users can be considered, but application for use must be completed and approved.</p>

*Each group is required to sign and enter into a Written Agreement with the City of Sevierville Parks and Recreation Department and provide proper Liability Insurance as per the Agreement.

*Match Play Events: No courts will be required to be left for open play.

* Private Rental Cost: \$5.00 per hour per court.



Lights

- Lights will be available at the Courts from March 1st thru December 30th each year. Lights will not be available from December 31st each year until February 28th of the following year.
- Lights will automatically come on at 6am until Sunrise each morning and again from Sunset to 10pm each evening.
- Lights cannot be used by Individuals or Groups; during any other times unless approved by the Director of Parks and Recreation
