Alcohol Agreement and Terms

- Groups holding functions held at the Civic Center may be permitted to serve alcoholic beverages
 upon approval from the Director of Parks and Recreation. Alcoholic beverages (including but not
 limited to beer, wine and liquor) may be served only by persons holding a current Server Permit
 issued by the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission.
- A \$600 cash deposit is required from any group serving alcoholic beverages PRIOR TO THE EVENT STARTING DATE AND TIME. The deposit will be refunded at the conclusion of the rental period, less any amounts necessary to reimburse the City for damage to the facility.
- A copy of the current Server Permit from the bartender working the event must be provided prior to the event date to keep with the Rental Agreement. The bartender must show such current and valid Server Permit again upon arrival on the date of the event to the Civic Center coordinator.
