

Trees Recommended for Planting – City of Sevierville

Small Trees (Usually do not exceed 30 feet in height):

- Carolina Silverbell (also Two-winged Silverbell)
- Dogwood (Flowering, Kousa, Pagoda)
- Eastern Redbud
- Flowering Crabapple
- Fringetree (American, Chinese)
- Foster Holly
- Hawthorn (Green, Washington, Thornless Cockspur)
- Paperbark Maple
- Oriental Cherries (Kwanzan, Okame, Yoshino)
- Red Buckeye
- Saucer Magnolia (also Star Magnolia)
- Allegheny Serviceberry
- Downy Serviceberry

Medium Trees (Usually from 30 to 50 feet mature height):

- American Holly
- American Yellowwood
- Arborvitae (numerous cultivars)
- Atlas Cedar
- Chinese Pistache
- Goldenraintree
- Hornbeam (American, European)
- Japanese Zelkova
- Overcup Oak
- Sourwood

- Sawtooth Oak
- Sweetbay Magnolia

Large Trees (Usually exceed 50 feet in height):

- American Beech
- Bald cypress
- Basswood (American Linden)
- Dawn Redwood
- Ginkgo (male only)
- Kentucky Coffeetree
- Littleleaf Linden
- London Planetree
- Nuttall Oak
- Red Maple (numerous varieties)
- Shumard Oak
- Southern Magnolia
- Sugar Maple (numerous varieties)
- Swamp White Oak
- Sweetgum (seedless varieties available)
- Thornless Honeylocust
- Willow Oak
- Yellow Poplar

Species of Trees NOT Recommended for Urban Planting

- Green & White Ash- Emerald Ash Borer
- Leyland Cypress- Seiridium canker
- Hemlock- Hemlock Woolly Adelgid

- American Elm- The threat of Dutch Elm Disease (resistant varieties can be used)
- Silver Maple- undesirable urban species
- Bradford Pear- undesirable urban species
